VD (5) 1 Rowan's Ch Degallo's The Vindicator At Rowancrest. Correct head topped with neat well placed ears, super construction, moved so well and in harmony with his owner, a worthy champion in full coat. 2 Rutterford's Ch Kelgrove Just Blue At Stormhead JW ShCM. A quality blue merle in great condition, moved with ease to cover the ground so well, true champion. 3 Moore's Shetlo Pocket Rainbeau.

MPD (5) 1 Redpath's Molson Miroquai. Very promising young sable, well balanced head, super shoulders, excellent presentation, sound on the move. One to watch. 2 Hill's Molson Milkybar Kid. Litter brother to the winner with many of the same excellent qualities, very interesting to watch them both progress. 3 Lycett's Iliad Isle Of Ewe.

PD (4,2) 1 Stafford's Rannerdale Showmaster. Just what I would expect from this kennel, super expressive head, lovely arched neck, well laid shoulders, sound mover and very well presented. Best PD. 2 Woolley's Jourdorill Moment In Time At Valjon. Well proportioned and balanced head, good straight front, lovely presentation, tended to pace on the move.

JD (4) 1 Miles' Keycharm Gold Standard At Milesend. Super head topped with neat well placed ears, lovely eye shape and set giving a melting expression, moved well to cover the ring with ease. 2 Walker's Tooralie's Ocho Rios JW. Another promising young sable with many of the quality of the class winner, very well presented.

YD (5) 1 Hull's Mohnesee's Dream Date Of Lizmark. Correct head, supported by a well arched neck, well angled front and rear, moved with ease and in harmony with his handler. 2 Goodwin's Highbrook Hobnob JW. Quality sable, head handles well, straight front, sound on the move. 3 Lee's Willowthorns Trushka.

GD (5, 1) 1 Gamble's Solyric Inaugural Gold JW. Excellent head giving a soft and yet alert expression, moved well to cover the ground with ease, well presented. 2 Hull's Mohnesee's Dream Date Of Lizmark. First in yearling. 3 Savage's Willowthorn Kobalt Star By Savataurus JW Jun Ch.

PGD (9, 2) 1 Forster Parish's Milesend Blue Raider At Lowick. A quality blue dog, correct balanced head, supportive neck set in good shoulders, good bone, moved well and with extension. 2 Daniels & Taylor's Pepperhill Cruise Control. Another quality blue, well laid shoulders, well angled stifle, moved with ease. 3 Isdale's Viewdale Cuddly Dudley JW.

LD (12, 2) 1 Chatterley's Silver Coin. Another super blue, balanced head, neat well used ears, lovely arched neck, well angled front and rear, moved with ease and in harmony with his handler. RCC. 2 Drysdale's Donallin Shadow Magic For Jondrea ShCM ShCEx. Sable dog with a balanced head, good front and rear angles, moved with drive. 3 Bendelow's Guxel Golden Ringer From Amethrickeh.

OD (7, 1) 1 Castillo & Pearson's GB Ir Ch Edglonian Blue Fortune. Eyecatching blue, super example of the breed, lovely soft expression, moved with ease to cover the ground with drive and extension. CC, and later BOB. 2 Rutterford's Evad Whougonnacall At Stormhead ShCM. This sable was in excellent condition, well made and moved so well. 3 Hill's Ch & Aust Ch Hartly How About Me For Molson (Imp).

VB (5) 1 Barnett's Ch Rainway Crystal Star JW. I have admired this bitch for a long time, excellent head, super expression, very well constructed, sound as a pound on the move, always presented to perfection, a worthy champion. BCC and BVIB. 2 Clegram's Smiddyshaw Relight My Fire ShCM. Super head and expression on this lovely tri bitch, she moved with ease and grace, she didn't look her 9 yrs. 3 Moore's Shetlo Love And Laughter.

MPB (3) 1 Hill's Molson It's Morven. A very promising young sable, head balanced and giving a lovely soft expression, moved so well for a youngster. One I will watch in the future. 2 Purves' Donallin Magic In Blue. This young blue needs more time to mature but she is a sound mover. Give her time. 3 Drysdale's Jondrea Heavens Dream.

PB (6) 1 Barrowclough's Shadowess True Blue. I was attracted to this blue pup as she entered the ring. Lovely balanced head, correct angulation front and rear, moved so well and in harmony with the young

man handling her. BPIB. 2 Sorockyj & Haine's Mohnesee Share The Dream. Balanced head, lovely eye, soft expression, well presented, moved well. 3 Wilson's Mohnesee Dare To Dream At Dasgeda.

JB (10) 1 Walker's Channerswick Pennywise JW. Yet another quality blue, balanced head, good straight front, moved well, excellent presentation. 2 Huyton's Jaztech Summer Love For Hightyne. Sable young lady, lovely expression, correct body tone, moved well and in harmony with the handler. 3 Bendelow's Shelegian Ring O'bells At Amethrickh.

YB (9) 1 Thornley & Withers' Mitchfields Fashion Girl At Felthorn. A very well broken quality blue merle, head handles well, neat ears, good angulation front and rear, moved so soundly, excellent presentation. 2 Hateley's Mohnesee Sweet Dreams JW. Lovely sable in super condition, moved with ease, very well presented. 3 Hickling's Sheltisha Belle Of The Ball At Natara TAF.

GB (9, 1) 1 Hill's Ellenyorn Exclusive To Molson. Quality sable, excellent presentation as I would expect from this kennel, lovely head, super flowing lines, moved so well. One to watch. 2 Withers' Neraklee Naomi At Stanydale. Lovely tri in good coat, soft Sheltie expression, moved well to cover the ground with ease. 3 Walley's Sandwick Prima Donna. **PGB (2)** 1 Walker's Tooralie's No No Nanette. This lovely black/white was in super coat, super head, well filled foreface, presented and shown so well, moved with ease. 2 Deveson's Milesend Sea Pearl. This young lady was a little apprehensive and unsettled, but she looks good when moving. **LB (11, 2)** 1 Pearson's Edglonian Rhythm N Rhyme. A very flashy tri in good coat, full white collar, balanced head topped with neat ears, well laid shoulders, moved with drive to cover the ground with ease. 2 Jones & Blackburn's Lavika Lucky Me. Quality sable, lovely outline, moved well, well presented. 3 Miles' Eljetia Hot Chocolate Of Milesend.

OB (10, 2) 1 Stafford's Ch Rannerdale Queen O'the North JW. Super example of the breed, excellent head, super angulation front and rear, moved as only a well made Sheltie can. A truly worthy champion. 2 Lycett's Herds Hallicia At Iliad. Balanced head, topped with neat well placed ears, lovely outline, moved well to cover the ground with ease. 3 Doyle's Ir Ch Sevenoaks Angel By My Side Jun Ch.
