MPD (6,1) 1. Winfield's Iskander Bohemia Classic for Oakcroft NAF. S/W, pleasing baby, head is well proportioned with flat skull and well rounded foreface, nicely placed ears, good reach of neck and angulation front and rear with graceful sweep over loin. Rennison's Zaniah's Illusionist. B/M 8 month old baby, well balanced head, correct shape eye, neatly placed ears, nice outline, moved well. Dillon's Lundecoeks Tempest In A Pot at Runforest (imp SWE).

PD (5) 1. Hawkins/Foy's Beldones Just A Hunch. S/W quality puppy, lovely head and eye giving a sweet yet masculine expression, good outline and angulation, in excellent coat, at times gave his handler a hard time but when settled moved well around the ring, BPD & BPIB. 2. Bastiani/John's Auberswell Andante. S/W in good coat and condition, well constructed, responded well to handler but I preferred the head pattern of the above. 3. Folkes' Navy Blue of Most Majestic at Dacfolke (imp HUN).

JD (1) 1. Berry/Clegram's Smiddyshaw Here I Go Again. A quality S/W dog, lovely head and eye giving a sweet yet masculine expression, well constructed with straight front, good depth of body, level top-line, nice sweep over the loin, he moved with good forward reach and drive which enabled him to move well around the ring, presented in immaculate condition, RDCC.

YD (3) 1. Winfield's Oakcroft The Mandalorian JW. S/W nicely balanced young male with masculine head, well constructed with straight front, good depth of body, level top-line, nice sweep over the loin, he moved with good forward reach and drive, showed non stop and responded well to handler. 2. Parker's Edglonian Prime Target with Tolarock. Good bone and straight front, well developed with good depth and spring of rib, presented in excellent condition, very attentive to handler, preferred the movement of 1. 3. Arkley's Amethrickeh Perfect Spirit.

PGD (8,3) 1. Pierce's Philhope In Good Taste. S/W spot on for size, correct wedge shaped head, flat skull, balanced foreface, well placed and shaped eye giving the desired expression, neat well carried ears, in gleaming coat of correct texture, moved and showed well. 2. Linford's Hillhenry In Your Honour. Tri, lovely shape and balanced in profile having a wedged shape head, topped with neat ears, flat skull, dark eye, well developed underjaw, good depth of body, in good coat, well presented, preferred the movement of 1. 3. Sutherland's Shelcrest Winter Solstice at Suthesley JW.

LD (12,1) 1. Brady/Lynn's Afterglow Sky Miles to Bordercot. B/M with a good reach of neck and level top-line, head is well balanced with a flat skull, good foreface and underjaw. Well presented, co-operated well with handler, moved freely around the ring. 2. Sorocky's Padawan Mandalorian. S/W, has a flat skull, well filled foreface, balanced head, good underjaw and correctly shaped and placed dark eye, good reach of neck, level top-line and slope over the croup, in good coat, well presented. 3. Mitchell's Valdosta Gracelands JW.

OD (6) 1. Pearson's Ch. Edglonian Golden Graham. What more can I say about this dog, he ticked all my boxes today, this dog who demanded my attention as he entered the ring, such a quality dog, presented in superb condition not a hair out of place, a superb example of our breed, a balanced dog, good depth of body and spring of ribs, superb hindquarters, excellent neck and shoulder he moved well with good front extension as his construction suggests. Head is well balanced with flat skull and well rounded foreface, the eye is dark and well placed giving the desired expression, I was very pleased to award him the DCC & BOB and to see later he won the Pastoral Group. 2. Walker's Ch/Fr/Sui/Lux/Int Ch. Tooralie's Pie In The Sky. TW shaded & white, a sound dog, excellent proportions, moulded wedge shaped head, flat skull, well placed correct dark eye, neat ears, arched neck of good length, balanced body shape, adequate bone, deep chest, level top-line, good sweep over croup, well let down hocks, moved soundly, presented in excellent condition. 3. Hull's Mohnesee's Dream Date of Lizmark JW.

VD (3) 1. Gamble's Solyric Inaugural Gold JW OSW. I have watched this well known S/W dog numerous occasions from the side of the ring and it was a pleasure to have the opportunity to go over him, good in angulation front and rear which enabled him to cover the ground well on the move, presented in excellent condition. 2. Lycett's Forestland Galaxy TAF. Spot on for size, his overall

balance is correct, he is of good breed type, a strong well made dog who moved well around the ring, unlucky to meet 1 on this occasion, quite sure will change places. 3. Bird/Caden's Molson Mr Blue Sky JW.

SpBD (3) 1. Clough's Evad Lite Breeze. S/W in good coat and condition, co-operated well with handler. 2. Ferguson's Dinmore Wild Blue Yonder of Fervaila. 15 month old B/M a little on the top size but his handler got the best out of him. 3. Clayson's Lavika's Prince Misha.

MPB (5,1) 1. Pierce's Philhope Clearly Precious. 6 month old S/W baby with correct wedge shape head, flat skull and correct stop, attractive outline with graceful sweep over the croup, moved freely for one so young. 2. Hawkins' Lavika Rosemary and Thyme for Brilyn. 7 month old S/W slightly bigger than one with a racy outline, balanced head with good stop, flat skull and good ear carriage, just needs more coat to complete the picture. 3. Haensel's Sherkarl Blue Elegance.

PB (5,2) 1. Mayhew's Sandwick Saffron Gold. Very feminine S/W of correct size and type, attractive outline and wedge shape head with a flat skull and round foreface. Neatly placed ears and good eye placement giving the desired expression, moved well around the ring. 2. Gruszka's Achor's Surprise Himalaya over Samphrey (imp CHE) NAF. Not as mature as one, a B/M of good colour having a wedge shaped balanced head, pleasing outline, just needs time. 3. James' Valmay Victoriana.

JB (9,4) 1. Sorockyj's Shazbec Maid of Honour at Sheltisha. B/M of good colour, lovely head and expression with well moulded foreface and neat ears, good bone and attractive outline, good front and rear angulation which enabled her to move well around the ring, has a bright future. 2. Clegram's Smiddyshaw All The Glitz. Attractive tri of correct size, pleasing outline and well balanced head, flat skull and level top-line, neat well carried ears which she used to full advantage, well constructed which showed when on the move. 3. Rennison's Sandwick Iridescent to Zaniah.

YB (6,2) 1. Hayhurst's Keycharm Sweet Candy. S/W of ideal size in excellent coat and condition, lovely wedge shaped head, flat skull, rounded muzzle, well placed and shaped dark eye giving that desired sweet expression, neat well carried ears which she used to full advantage, attractive outline and moved freely round the ring. 2. Weller's Evad Halloween Spice. S/W well balanced head with moulded foreface topped with neat ears, good front and rear angulation, level top-line with graceful sweep over the croup, moved well, two bitches with a bright future, a close decision between 1 & 2 but just preferred the eye shape of one. 3. Forbes' Jontygray Gypsy Queen of Wellneuk.

PGB (14,8) 1. Sorockyj's Sheltisha Royal Approval. B/M of good colour and correct size, balanced head, nicely constructed front and rear which showed when on the move, used her ears to full advantage, co-operated well with handler. 2. Jackson's Ribans Starlet of Milesend (JKC). S/W with well balanced head, flat skull and correct stop, well placed eye giving a sweet expression, neat well carried ears which she used well, in good coat and condition, responded well to handler. 3. Hirst's Sundark Symphony in Suede.

LB (8,3) 1. Jeavons' Wylwind Designed for Grandgables (imp SAF) JW. Tri of ideal size, wedge shaped head with flat skull and correct stop, well placed eye giving a sweet expression topped with neat well carried ears, good hind angulation, elegant on the move and her handler made the most of her first class presentation, RBCC, I was pleased to be informed this made her a Champion under the new rules. 2. Mitchell's Valdosta Goddess JW. S/W presented in excellent condition, in good coat of correct texture, correct wedge shaped feminine head, flat skull and correct stop, attractive outline and level top-line with graceful sweep over the croup, moved well around the ring, sure her day will come. 3. Rosslyn's Balidorn Golden Amber.

OB (7,1) 1. Doyle's Sevenoaks Angel's Reflection. Elegant S/W with very attractive outline, correct wedge shaped head, well placed and shaped dark eye, neat well placed ears which she used to full advantage, moved around the ring with drive and style and co-operated fully with her handler, pressed hard for the RBCC. 2. Bastiani/John's Rannerdale She's A Lady of Auberswell. Another feminine S/W with an attractive outline of ideal size with a well balanced head and sweet expression, co-operated well with her handler and moved round the ring with drive. 3. Rennison's Esterbon Bi Storm to Zaniah.

VB (5) 1. Clegram/Berry's Smiddyshaw I'll B There for U JW VW. 9 years old S/W who caught my eye as she entered the ring, a bitch of ideal size, immaculately presented, well constructed front and rear with a well balanced head and nicely placed ears which she used to full advantage, moved freely around the ring, I was pleased to award her third BCC & BV, long overdue. 2. Lycett's Herds Hallicia at Iliad. S/W of correct size, well balanced head with flat skull and correct stop, neat ears which she used to advantage, in lovely coat and condition and was in complete harmony with her handler. 3. Deveson's Janetstown Je Suis JW.

SpBB (6,2) 1. Ferguson's Sandwich Valentina at Fervaila. Not in the best of coats today, responded well to handler. 2. Ridehalgh's Royal To Do. 10 month baby needs to mature. 3. Lee's Castlerose In Spirit at Chalynwood.
