

## SCOTTISH BREEDS 31<sup>ST</sup> March 2018

**VD** (6, 1) 1. Main's Shenachie Night Jar. Almost 8-year old tricolour dog of correct size and proportions. Good Sheltie type with well-fitting coat. Nice head, eye and ear carriage. Unsettled on the move. Best Veteran Dog. 2. Jackson Ir Ch Fernach Blue Rhapsody at Cluainultaigh. Attractive 7-year old blue-merle with a well-moulded head, correct stop and good ear placement. Balanced in outline with good front and rear angulation. 3. Pattinson Kyleburn Acis.

**MPD** (3) 1. Edwards Castlerose Foxtrot. Very raw 6-month old sable puppy of appealing type. Well-made fore and aft. Head needs to broaden, but produces a good expression. Moved very well for one so young. 2. Johnson, Jacobs & Johnson Willowthorn Dream Gazer. Almost 9 month old and very mature, this sable puppy is of stronger type than 1. Nicely angulated rear, with correct hock and strong bone. Well moulded head and good expression. 3. Proctor Stiosan Still Game.

**PD** (3) 1. Nixon Japaro Music Maestro. Very attractive sable puppy with lovely head, eye and ear carriage, producing a sweet expression. Well balanced with good front & rear angulation and correct outline. A bit unsettled on the move. Best Puppy Dog & Best Junior Dog. 2. Mottram Lanteague Gold Sovereign at Lochkaren. Another attractive sable puppy of good type in full coat. I loved his expression, produced by a well-moulded head, which was proudly carried on a good length of neck, and correct eye and ear placement. 3. Pattinson Kyleburn Romulus.

**JD** (4) 1. Mottram Lanteague Gold Sovereign at Lochkaren. 2. Johnson, Jacobs & Johnson Willowthorn Dream Gazer. 3. Bird & Caden Molson Mr Blue Sky.

**GD** (7) 1. Isdale Viewdale Cuddly Dudley JW. Golden sable dog of good type. Good head and expression. Presents a nice overall picture with good angulation and a well-fitting coat. The best mover in this class. 2. Goodwin Highbrook He's Got Style JW. Another golden sable dog of pleasing proportions. Very nice in outline, produced by good overall construction, correct length of neck and correct coat. Just preferred the expression of 1. 3. Bird & Caden Molson Mr Blue Sky.

**PGD** (6) 1. Jackson Shellamoyed The Kingsman. Well-balanced sable dog of correct size and nice head and expression. OK construction and good in outline with adequate length of neck. Moved well. 2. Lycett Iliad Isle Spy. Nice lean moulded head on this shaded sable, with correct ear and eye placement. Good front and rear angulation, but slightly longer in leg and shorter in neck. Good mover. 3. Sangster Amethrickeh Storm Wizzard.

**LD** (9) 1. Withers Stanydale Shot In The Dark JW. Delightful tricolour, with well-fitting jet black coat and rich tan markings. Perfectly balanced, lovely front and rear angulation and correct length of back. Head carried proudly on long neck and giving the classic Sheltie outline. Correct head with well-placed stop, good eye shape and ear carriage, giving sweet expression. Moved a dream. Dog CC 2. Gatheral Herds Humphrey JW. Golden sable that also produces a lovely overall picture. Well moulded-head, good eye, small ears, beautiful expression. Good length of back, well made and moved very well. Reserve Dog CC. 3. Mottram Midday Sun at Lochkaren JW.

**OD** (4) 1. Goodwin Sandwick Turn Back Time at Highbrook. Rather plain tricolour with jet black, correctly-fitting coat with rich tan markings. Slightly smaller in size, but balanced. Nice head and expression. Very well made, lovely in outline and moved very well. 2. Edwards Castlerose Spiritmaster JW ShCM. Masculine blue merle dog of slightly bigger type. Nicely broken and with rich tan. Good expression, well made, nice in outline and moved well. 3. Procter Our Little Drummer Boy.

**VB** (4) What a class! All four of these veterans could change places on another day. 1. Forbes Wellneuk Dancing Waters JW ShCM. Pretty 7-year old shaded sable of excellent type that I have judged before. Can't believe she's a veteran. Refined head and expression. Excellent construction, lovely in outline and moved well. 2. Gatheral Herds Hallucination JW. Lovely 7-year old tricolour bitch with a jet black coat that fitted the body well. White collar and good tan markings. Beautiful construction, good length of neck and back, lovely in outline. Nice head and expression and another very good mover. 3. Lycett Shebaville Saucy Secret at Iliad JW.

**MPB** (3) 1. Hateley Mohnesee Millybelle. Sweet 7-month old puppy, so typical of this kennel. Refined head, that just needs to mature, lovely expression. Nice front and rear angulation, lovely overall picture and moved ok. 2. Elder Ellenyorn Evita. Just 6-months old, this raw, golden sable bitch has the makings of a nice head and expression. Very unsettled on the move, needs time. 3. Main Shenachie Black Swallow.

**PB** (4, 1) 1. Nixon Japaro It's All About Me. Lovely golden sable bitch, litter brother to my Best Puppy Dog. Lovely moulded head, correct almond-shaped eye, good ear carriage, sweet expression. Good in outline with correct length of neck and back, well constructed, pleasing outline. A good mover. Best Puppy Bitch & Best Puppy in Breed. 2. Withers Neraklee Naomi at Stanydale. Sired by my Dog CC winner, this is a lovely tricolour puppy of similar type. Correct head type, excellent construction, a classic outline, she moved with drive. Just preferred the expression of 1. 3. Redpath Sonymer Storm Doris

**JB (3)** 1. Thornley Shellbrook Pandora with Felthorn. Very elegant sable bitch of classic proportions. She is hard to fault with a refined head and expression, excellent construction and movement. Correct length of back and neck, along with good angulation, produces that beautiful Sheltie outline. Reserve Bitch CC & Best Junior in Breed. 2. Hateley Sanscott Sweet Serenity at Mohnessee JW. Golden sable bitch with lovely head, correct almond-shaped eye and good expression. Lovely in outline, she moved well. A quality bitch. 3. Purves Donallin Dream Girl.

**NB (6, 1)** 1. Withers Neraklee Naomi at Stanydale 2. Hateley Mohnessee Millybelle 3. Redpath Sonymer Storm Doris.

**GB (7)** 1. Elder Ellenyorn Echo Falls. I liked the head and expression on this golden sable bitch, who is in full coat and lovely in outline. Nice on the move. 2. Forbes Wellneuk Dancing Flame JW. Another sable bitch of good type. Nice head, good eye and ear carriage, good expression. Good front angulation and length of neck, but perhaps a little too long in back for balance. Moved ok. 3. Purves Sommerville Magic In Black

**PGB (7)** 1. Greenhill Mohnessee Diamonds 'N' Pearls JW. Blue merle bitch of good colour, but with some heavier black marking. I liked her head and expression and her outline and she moved well. 2. Dunn Neraklee Chardonnay at Shelleary. Correct head and ear carriage on this sable bitch, but would have preferred a slightly smaller eye to produce the correct expression. Balanced in outline and moved well today. 3. Main Shenachie Lyric Of Light

**LB (7, 1)** 1. Thomas Myter Trade Secret. Blue merle bitch of correct size and type. Lovely head and expression. Very good construction, good length of back and neck, producing a lovely, balanced overall picture and excellent movement. 2. Wyper Murieston Classic Design. Golden sable bitch, she is well constructed with a nice head and expression and a nice overall outline. Moved well. 3. Smith Orean Bootleg Babe.

**OB (4)** 1. Thomas Myter Guilty Pleasure JW. Really sound blue merle bitch of excellent construction and overall proportions. Lovely moulded head, well-filled foreface, good underjaw, nice eye. Presents the perfect picture of expression and outline and a lovely mover. Another that I couldn't believe was a veteran! Bitch CC, Best Veteran Bitch, Best of Breed & Best Veteran in Breed 2. Clegram Simcourt The Show Must Go On at Smiddyshaw. Really pretty golden sable bitch. Excellent angulation, lovely balance in profile. Slightly finer in bone and foreface than 1. Moved well. 3. Lycett Iliad Isabear Secret
