JD (3) 1 Norris Ferngrove's Valentino JW. Glamorous sable dog. Nice muzzle and good ear carriage. Neck of suitable length. Good length of body and depth of chest. Overall Balance and shape good. Nicely fitted coat of good texture. 2 Barrowclough Shadowess Jubilee Prince. Sable with a nicer head pattern than 1. Nicely filled muzzle, correctly placed stop and neat ear carriage. Good overall body and shape. Unfortunately front angulation not as good as one. 3 Stock Shemist Summertime Blues.

ND (1) 1 Stock Shemist Suumertime Blues. 3rd in previous class. Nicely coloured glamorous merle. Correct length of body and well fitted coat. Nice length of tail. A bit erratic on the move.

GD (2) 1 Varnom Milesend Black Tartan. Well coated tricolour with a good muzzle and neat ear carriage. Nice bone and good feet. Neck a little short and the movement a little laboured. 2 Dimmock Milesend Silver Thorn. Head quite good as were legs and feet. A nicely fitted coat with a good length of tail. Moved reasonably well.

PGD (4) 1 Dimmock Shougies Secret Agent for Fernhill. Really nice tricolour with an exceptionally well balanced and correct head. Lovely muzzle and good parallel plains. Good eye shape and colour and neat ear set. Neck, length of body, depth of chest, all very good. Legs and feet also. Moved very well. 2 Ayres Gemette Gone Platinum. Very nice well broken blue with a good head held on long neck and good depth of chest. Moved well. Smart well balanced outline. 3 Varnom Milesend Blue Jeans.

LD 1 Pattinson Kyleburn Hidden Dream. A sable with a pleasing head and expression. Overall balance and shape good. Moved really well as expected from his sound construction. Showed well. 2 Gamble Solyric Inaugural Gold JW. Similar to one with head and overall balance. Movement almost as good and showed well. 3 Barrowclough Shadowess Lockdown Hero.

OD (3,2a) 1 Pearson Ch Edglonian Golden Graham. A sable with a huge amount of quality, beautiful head, good reach of neck, length of body, depth of chest, legs and feet, beautifully presented in dense coat and with good movement. **RCC. VD (2)** 1 Bray Ch Lianbray Lothario. Head of very good pattern. Lovely muzzle with parallel plains. Eyes well set. Ears a little high. Good length of body and depth of chest. Well fitted coat. Good legs and feet, moved and showed well. 2 Pattinson Kyleburn Everlasting Dream. Good head with a lovely muzzle ears carried well, eyes well set. Good length of body and depth of chest moved and showed well. **Special Open Sable and White (1)** 1 Fisher Ch Shellamoyed Gold Fever. A beautiful sable. Head absolutely top quality with nice parallel plains good eye colour and set and ears well carried. Nice length of neck and depth of body. Overall balance and shape very good. Nice legs and feet. Well fitted coat and texture. Moved well although hind movement not extended as much as I would have liked. CC.

Special Open Tri/black and Tan/Black and white (2) 1 Hardy Sandwick Style Council. Another sound dog with a nicely balanced head with correct eye shape and colour. Ears well carried. Good angulation and overall balance. Legs and feet good. Nice size and substance with nicely fitted coat. Moved and showed well. 2 Pattinson Kyleburn Romulus. Tri colour a little bigger than ideal. A good head and length of body. Nice neck and depth of chest Overall balance and shape good. Moved and showed well.

Special Open Blue Merle (2) 1 Stock Shemist Sea Dragon. Blue dog with a nice head, and good substance. Nicely fitted coat and good feet and legs. Moved well. 2 Ayres Gemette Gone Platinum.
