My co-judge Mrs M Daniels and myself were in complete agreement on every joint decision which was great. BIS was Stafford's, Rannerdale Showmaster. RBIS was Dunne's, Japaro I Have a Dream. BPIS was Dunn's, Brilyn Baccarat Crystal to Beechmere. BVIS was Parkes', Ch. Milesend Gold Taken at Eljetia.

**MPD (5).** 1. Botham's, Balidorn Charmer. 6 month old. Nice size, bone and proportions. Almond shaped eye, flat skull and neat ears giving a pleasant expression and showing intelligent. Balanced all over and moving very well. Positive sensible temperament. Should have a good future. 2. Gruszka's, Japaro Timeless Design for Samphrey. Almost 9 month old. Correct size for age. Coat is coming, pleasant colour. Not the expression of eye as winner. Moving well and easy. Temperament very good. 3. Bastiani and John's, Lirren Showtime Joins Auberswell.

**PD. (2).** 1. Lycett's, Iliad Isle Delight. S/w. Good outline with coat coming full ruff and petticoats. Liked almond shaped eye, flat skull and neat ears which are being used well. Good size and with a sweep over the loins. Moves well and easy. Good temperament. 2. Wither's, Mitchfields Dizzie Rascal at Stanydale. Nice make and shape and therefore moves so well and easy. Didn't think head was correct, too straight through. Also too thin in body condition.

**JD. (3).** 1. Stafford's, Rannerdale Showmaster. S/W. Masculine dog has flat skull, almond shaped eye. Nice bone. Good ribs and sweep over loins. Good length of tail. Excellent temperament. All quality with correct balance overall. CC and BIS. 2. Winfield's, Aventurine Bohemia Classic Joins Oakcroft. S/w. More compact with nice fitting coat that is well presented. Small ears, flat skull, would like more underjaw. Moved well and easy. Good temperament. 3. Pattinson's, Kyleburn Hidden Dream.

**YD. (4).** 1. Goodwin's, Highbrook Hobnob JW. Sable in very good body condition with muscle. Good coat, bone and size. Stop a little too steep, ears nice and good teeth. Moves freely and well. Excellent temperament. 2. Walker's, Tooralies Ocho Rios. Preferred the head of this one, but not moving so well and has a short tail. Good general outline and temperament. Coat fits well. Excellent temperament.

**MD. (2).** 1. Japaro Timeless Design for Samphrey.

**ND.** 1. Lycett's, Iliad Isle of Ewe. Good size and type. Coat is coming well for 10 months. Almond eye, flat skull, nice stop. Flowing lines and nice type. Moves very well. 2. Bastiani and John's, Lirren Showtime Joins Auberswell. Good body condition with a good sweep over loins. Has nice bone and right feet. Flat skull, would like a bit more wedge shape. Didn't handle on the table in his first class.

**GD. (3).** 1. Aventurine Bohemia Classic Joins Oakcroft. 2. Botham's, Balidorn Black Spice. Good size, bone and in good body condition with overall correct type. Head I think would be better with flatter skull, eye too round and stop too steep. Moved well. 3. Sutherland's, Richmaus Ted Boy.

**PGD. (7).** 1. Bird and Caden', Molson Mr Blue Sky. Good size and balanced. Coat is coming. Liked bone and solid body with muscle. Calm sensible temperament. Flat skull and almond eye. Moves well and easy. Ears could be tighter. 2. Officer's, Castlerose A Shropshire Lad JW Sh CM. Masculine head and bone. Good shaped eye, flat skull and small well placed ears. Lacking coat under belly. Excellent calm temperament. 3. Pattison's, Kyleburn Everlasting Dream.

**LD. (6).** 1. Robinson's, Lavika Lush Life. Good outline with a neck flowing lines with sweep over loin. Liked wedge shaped head, flat skull and almond shaped eye. More strength of underjaw would be just right. Solid body with masculine bone and tight feet. Coat is coming. Great calm intelligent temperament. 2. Robinson's, Sheltysam Nutbox in Alnmac. Correct make and shape. Such a good mover. Coat needs better presentation as it is hiding the qualities of construction. 3. Gamble's, Solyric Inaugural Gold JW.

**OD. (6).** 1. Stafford's, Ch. Rannerdale the Entertainer. Sable. Nice coat with petticoats. Flat skull, wedge shaped head and good foreface, would like eye to be larger. Balanced overall and moves so well. Excellent temperament and in good body condition. 2. Reeves', Ir/UK Ch. Fearnach Crusader. Tri. Another good coat and in very good body condition. Wedge shaped head and good foreface, would like less stop. Good bone, body and moving well and easy. Excellent temperament. 3. Robert's, Ch. Malaroc Mystery Writer JW.

**VD. (5).** 1. Pattison's, Kyleburn Acis. Liked head, skull and almond eye, great teeth and in very nice body for 11 and a half years old. Moves well and easy. 2. Gruszka's, Samphrey Moonlight Shadow JW. Tri Good construction and moving with ease. Nice neck and topline. 3. Tucker's, Sandiacre Set in Ice.

**OD S/W** 1. Robinson's, Ch. Lavika Luminary JW. Good topline flowing well. Liked size of eye and shape. Showing well with good coat, bone and temperament. Nice size and balance. Excellent conformation with correct length of neck. RCC. 2. Gatherall's, Ch. Herds Humphrey JW. Similar to winner but not the neck reach of winner in very nice body condition. Shows well with excellent temperament and gain balance. 3. Solyric Inaugural Gold JW.

**OD TRI** 1. Wither's, Ch. Stanydale Shot in the Dark JW. Excellent body with good front. Masculine bone, tight feet and moving with purpose. Shows non-stop giving a good outline.

**OD B/M** 1. Bastiani and John's, Ch. Hawk Blue Eyes des Romarins de Mayerling Joins Auberswell. Solid dog with excellent length of neck. Good rib and sweep over loin. Excellent bone and feet. Excellent movement which was dead sound and true. 2. Edward's, Castlerose Spiritmaster JW ShCM. Another nice one. Excellent body condition. Good bone and feet. Not the coat of winner.

**MPB (12,3)** 1 Ulsen & Wyler's Dandlewood Easy Peasy. Lovely headed sable and white with a nice dark eye. Well placed ears which she used non stop. Ample bone. Good arched neck leading to well laid shoulders. Firm topline which she maintained on the move. Long tail. Good bend of stifle giving drive from the rear. 2 Ulsen & Wyler's Dandlewood Endless Surprise. Litter sister to the winner, similar in type. Just preferred the head on my first. 3 Robinson's Lavika Hi Vida.

**PB (5, 1)** 1 Dunn's Brilyn Baccarat Crystal To Beechmere. BPIS. Pale sable and white who has a very feminine head, well shaped and placed dark eye, ears well used all giving a lovely expression. Ample bone for her size. Long neck and good body proportions. Moved well coming and going 2nd Mottram's Mohnesee Such A Dream At Lochkaren JW. Another nice puppy of heavier build than the winner, but has a lot to like, pleasing expression, moved well.

**JB (9, 3)** 1 Dunn's Brilyn Baccarat Crystal To Beechmere. 2 Sapsford Shelcrest River Of Dreams. Shaded sable. Slightly smaller than my winner. Pleasing head, used her ears well. Good showgirl. 3 Barrowclough's Shadowess True Blue.

**YB (11, 2)** 1 Thornley & Withers Mitchfields Fashion Girl At Felthorn. Blue merle bitch with a pleasing eye and neat ears. A well constructed bitch with good arched neck leading to a good lay of shoulder, level topline maintained on the move. Won this class on her overall soundness. 2 Dunne's Longrange Ciao Bella Blue. Lovely coloured Blue, she has a lovely eye, well used ears, good rounded bone. Moved well just preferred the outline of my winner. 3 Hardman's Seavall Taran.

**MB (7)** 1 Robinson's Lavika Hi Vida. Third in MP, nice puppy, moved and showed well, just needs time. 2 Winfield's Oakcroft Tiana. Reserve in MP, another nice puppy that just needs time. 3 Barrowclough's Shadowess True Blue.

**NB (7)** 1 Dunn's Brilyn Baccarat Crystal To Beechmere. 2 Robinson's Lavika Star Babe. Another promising baby with a nice eye and expression. Good shape and moved well, unfortunate to meet my winner not quite as mature. 3 Barrowclough's Shadowess True Blue.

**GB (9, 5)** 1 Withers' Neraklee Naomi At Stanydale. Pleasing head with the correct amount of stop. Nice dark eye. Used her ears non stop. Good level topline, moved well. 2 Welford's Ristine Emerald. Slightly larger than the first, but has a lot to like. Moved well. 3 Dick's Picture Perfect.

**PGB (11)** 1 Hateley's Mohnesee Sweet Dreams JW. Sable and white, beautifully presented. Has a lovely head and her correct shaped and placed eye giving the desired Sheltie expression. Good shoulders, level topline, good bend of stifle. Moved well. Pleased to award her the RCC. 2 Roberts' Malaroc Rainfall. Golden sable carrying a

wealth of coat in beautiful condition. Has the desired expression. Moved and showed well. 3 Thornley's Shelbrook Pandora With Felthorn.

**LB** (11, 2) 1 Dunne's Japaro I Have A Dream. RBIS & BOS. What a dream she is, my star of the day. Well presented sable and white, in fabulous condition. Most beautiful head properties, correct placed and shaped dark eye, neat ears which she knew how to use. Lovely round bone. Correct body shape, finished off with a long sweeping tail and short hocks. Movement first class. Pleased to award her her first CC, I am sure the other two will surely come. 2 Major's Mistyisle Simoncelli's Star. Tricolour with a jet black coat, and brilliant white markings. Nice body shape, good reach of neck, level topline, moved well. Unlucky to meet my winner today. 3 Deveson's Janetstown Je Suis JW ShCM.

**OB** (5, 3) 1 Stafford's Ch Rannerdale Queen O' The North. What is there to say about this beautiful girl that hasn't already been said? She has a lovely body shape, well rounded bone, good head and expression. Neat ears. Moved like a dream. Groomed to perfection as always from this kennel. A very worthy champion. 2 Hardy's Sandwich Stage Show. Shaded sable on more racy lines. Neat ears pleasing expression. Moved well.

**VB** (8, 2) 1 Parkes' Ch Milesend Gold Token At Eljetia JW. BVIS. I think this veteran is what we all strive for in our veterans. She is 10 years of age and still looking very youthful. A lovely bitch of super construction. Correct head properties, nice eye giving desired expression. She was a little reluctant to show me her ears today, but could not be denied this place. 2 Bray's Ruscombe Strikes A Light At Lianbray. At almost 9 years of age still looking quite youthful. Pleasing head and expression. Correct size with good bone. Moved well. 3 Lycett's Ch Shebaville Saucy Secret At Iliad.

**Sable/White** (8) 1 Barnett & Hardman's Rainway Returning To Seavall JW. Well constructed girl who gives her all. Pleasing head to handle. Neat ears, well laid back shoulders, level topline, Long tail. Moved well. 2 Stafford's Ch Rannerdale Queen Of Hearts JW. Another one who belies her 10 years. Well constructed bitch, with correct head and expression. Moved well.

**Tricolour** (8) 1 Robinson's Lavika Black Beauty JW. I have admired this girl from the ringside and was not disappointed on handling her. Lovely head properties, well placed and shaped dark eye. Small ears which she shows non stop. Good lay of shoulder, firm topline. Well rounded bone, good bend of stifle. Expertly shown by her young handler. Strong contender for one of the tickets. 2 Gatheral's Herds Hallucination JW. Hard to believe she is 9 years old, she looks and handles like a much younger bitch. 3 Major's Mistyisle Simoncelli's Star.

**Blue Merle** (8,2) 1 Ambler's Watchwood Sweetheart At Chalmoor. Lovely coloured girl beautifully presented, spot on for size, Has a sweet expression, lovely dark eye and neat ears not often seen in a blue. Level topline. Moved well. Shows great ring presence, on her toes throughout. 2 Barnett's Ch Rainway Crystal Star JW. A well known blue merle champion very worthy of her title. She has a lovely expression. Moves well coming and going. Just had to give way to youth on the day. 3 Major's Edglonian Blue Belle.

**Resident in Wales** (1) 1 Venton's Tri 'N Stop Me At Mistyisle. Stood alone in the class but deserved her first place. Jet black tricolour. Pleasing head. Moved and showed well.
