- **MPD** (5,1) 1. Rutherford's Myter Black Tarquin at Stormhead. Lovely tri boy of the correct size, nicely made with good bone, pleasing head and expression, neat ears which he used well, moved freely to take this class. 2. Hardy's Sandwick Ace of Hearts. 8 month b/w promising youngster, spot on for size, head held proudly on good reach of neck, level top-line, coat coming in well and beautifully presented. 3. Robinson's Alnmac We Will Rock You.
- **PD** (2,1) 1. Jeavons' Grandgenes Hey Good Lookin. 11 month old sable, well presented in good coat and condition, nice to go over on the table, balanced head and well placed dark eyes, well handled when moving, just slightly proud of his tail today.
- **JD** (4) 1. Winfield's Oakcroft The Mandalorian. Just coming up to 18 months and maturing nicely, coat fitting him well, well balanced head and expression, neat ears which he used well, ample bone and good feet, straight front and level top-line. 2. Walker's Grandgenes Kensington by Tooralie. Shaded sable not carrying a lot of coat today and a little more weight would be an advantage but handled well on the table and is well made, covered the ground well when moving. 3. Fagg's Valdosta Lionking at Lynscot.
- **YD** (5,3) 1. Johnson/Jacobs' Willowthorn's Happy Gaze. Sable of good breed type, good head shape and pleasing eye placement, would have preferred slightly better shoulder angulation but having said that he moved well round the ring with drive. 2. Stockden's Willowgarth Unlimited Love. Well presented golden sable, balanced head and ear carriage, good bone and feet, needs time to mature.
- **ND** (7,1) 1. Johnson/Jacobs' Willowthorn's Happy Gaze. Repeat. 2. Rutherford's Myter Black Tarquin at Stormhead. Repeat. 3. Fagg's Valdosta Lionking at Lynscot.
- **GD** (5) 1. Varnom's Milesend Black Tartan. Tricolour carrying a wealth of jet black coat and put down in good condition, nice size with plenty of bone, good wedge shaped head with a pleasing expression, top-line level and sweep over loin, long tail, a sound mover. 2. Robertson's Afterglow Goldberg at Vidlinvoe JW. Shaded sable, pleasing shape, good head pattern just not the sweet expression of 1, top-line level and well let down hocks, in good body condition. 3. Durrant's Borderpride Viva Las Vegas at Lodurr.
- **PGD** (9,1) 1. Hirst's Sundark Scaramouche. Handsome dog coming up for 2½ years, good outline and balanced head with lovely expression and well set ears, reachy neck and nice bone and feet, firm body and well let down hocks and long tail, moved well. 2. Cheal's Carolelen Composer at Faemadra. Sable dog who was pleasing to go over and has a nice head with dark well set eyes, good neck, bone and feet, good free mover. 3. Hardy's Sandwick Style Council. **LD** (12,3) 1. Lambert's Blenmerrow Merry Minstrel. Shaded sable, lovely sound dog of breed type, well constructed throughout, good head properties and soft expression, good reach of neck, firm top-line and sweep over loins, not carrying wealth of coat today but moved effortlessly around the ring to clinch this place. 2. Smee's Wansvale Amiable. Shaded sable presented in lovely condition, he too is well made with good bone, nice feet and was handled well, moved and showed well. 3. Mottram's Lundecock's Hoopie-Doo at Lochkaren JW (imp SWE).
- **OD** (7,1) 1. Pearson's Ch. Edglonian Golden Graham. Golden sable in full coat presented in pristine condition, every hair gleaming in the sunshine today, lovely moulded head with correct dark eye placement and neat ears, good strong bone and depth of chest and balanced body and sweep over loin, moved soundly as his construction would suggest, DCC. 2. French's Ch. Lindfern Light Sabre JW. Quality golden sable in full coat and beautifully presented, correct head pattern with the desired sweet expression and neat ears which he used well, excellent front and reach of neck, level top-line and sweep over loin, well let down hocks, moved with drive, RDCC. 3. Winfield's Ch. Lirren Quickstep to Oakcroft JW.

- **MPB** (7) 1. Sorockyj's Shazbec Maid of Honour at Sheltisha. Blue merle with lovely head and good eye placement and underjaw, nice for size and her well presented coat fitting her well, good outline, moved out well and used her ears to advantage. 2. Robertson's Edglonian The Vixen. Sable girl not as mature as 1 but a lovely shape and correct size, she has a pleasing head and a good reachy neck, coat coming in, she moved out well to gain this place. 3. Hateley's Mohnesee Lullaby Ice.
- **PB** (6) 1. Lambert's Blenmerrow Lullaby. A very eye-catching sable with a lovely head and sweet expression, nice for size, she has a pleasing outline, good neck and length of back, level top-line and sweep over loin, her coat fitting her nicely, lovely on the move, showed well, BP. 2. Allsopp's Grandgenes She Has The Look. Shaded sable, good to go over, pleasing head shape and eye placement, nice straight front and good feet, she moved well, just slightly proud of her tail today. 3. Hateley's Mohnesee Lullaby Ice.
- **JB** (4) 1. French's Skeldale Wish Upon A Star over Lindfern (imp NLD). Pretty golden sable having a nicely balanced head and good foreface, good neck and bone, coat well presented and fitting her well, moved well just a little unsettled when standing. 2. Purchase's Puncknowle Lucy Blue. Nice size of good breed type, pleasing head, dark eyes and good underjaw, ears a little high set and unsettled, having said that she has good shoulder angulation and level top-line and moved well. 3. Hayhurst's Keycharm Sweet Candy.
- **YB** (8) 1. Hardy's Sandwick Valencia. Lovely blue merle bitch and so sound, good head carriage with well placed eyes and ears, excellent bone and front assembly, lovely top-line and well let down hocks, in full coat beautifully presented, moved freely with plenty of drive, stood and showed well. 2. Weller's Evad Halloween Spice JW. Feminine golden sable with a sweet expression, lovely reach of neck and good length of back, good angulation, nice bone and feet, level top-line and sweep over loin, sound on the move. 3. French's Skeldale Wish Upon A Star over Lindfern (imp NLD).
- **NB** (11) 1. Sorockyj's Shazbec Maid of Honour at Sheltisha. Repeat. 2. Jackson's Ribans Starlet of Milesend (IKC). Sable, again of perfect size, balanced head with sweet expression, lovely reach of neck and level top-line, correct shape over loin, good front and hind angulation, moved and showed well. 3. Allsopp's Grandgenes She Has The Look.
- **GB** (6,2) 1. Sutherland's Beechmere Beautiful at Holamber. Lovely golden sable of good breed type, good conformation and balance, nice head pattern with pleasing eye and ears, good bone and feet, her coat fitting her nicely, she moved well but a little less weight would be an advantage. 2. Carr's Wansvale Limelight. Sable of nice type, neat head and ears, she is a lovely shape and has a good front, bone and feet, top-line good and nice long tail, moved soundly. 3. Allen's Sanbrakel Sunshine Breeze.
- **PGB** (10,3) 1. Robinson's Alnmac Busy Being Fabulous. Tri, gleaming black coat of good texture, nice size and shape, correct head pattern and used her ears well, straight in front, good shoulder angulation and rear, sound mover. 2. Smee's Wansvale Beyond Belief. Shaded sable, a tad larger than one but a nice shape and well presented, good to go over, pleasing expression and nice straight front and top-line, moved freely but needs to watch her weight. 3. Hickling's Sheltisha Bell of the Ball at Natara JW.
- **LB** (11,1) 1. Bray's Dandlewood Kiss 'n Tell at Lianbray (imp NLD). Lovely feminine golden sable, just turned 2 years, attractive head with dark eyes and neat ears which she used well, good neck carriage and upper arm, just the right amount of bone for her size, a steady mover and carrying just enough coat to take the RBCC. 2. Hirst's Sundark Spirit Mistress. Tri colour in good coat of correct texture, spot on for size, good head pattern and soundly constructed, lovely rounded bone and tail carriage, moved well. 3. Lambert's Blenmerrow Daisychain.
- **OB** (3) 1. Hateley's Ch. Lizmark Lullaby Moon over Mohnesee JW. Delightful blue merle, coat of lovely colour and texture, racy outline, lovely balance of head and expression, good reach of neck and body angulation and length of back and bend of stifle, good tail carriage, moved with drive when viewed from all directions, well presented and showed well, BCC. Today I felt she

could not be denied BOB on her lovely movement, she then went on to win the Pastoral Group, well done. 2. Pearson's Edglonian Slack Alice. Lovely sable of excellent breed type, stood four square, she handled well on the table, wedge shaped head, dark eyes and good underjaw, excellent bone and feet, well presented, moved soundly and showed well. 3. Coppock/White's Dinmore Blonde Ambition.

VB (7,2) 1. Lambert's Blenmerrow Night Music. Very pretty tri colour, correct size, pleasing head shape, good neck and top-line, nice straight front, although not in her best jacket what she had was well presented and you could see her lovely shape, she moved out well which won her this place, BV. 2. Hirst's Sundark Simply A Star VW. Lovely breed type carrying a wealth of coat, balanced head, she has good bone and feet, level back and nice tail carriage, stood and showed well. 3. Arnould's Shadoway Perchance to Dream JW.
